The CCNP is making available up to 6 travel awards for research trainees who would not otherwise be able to attend the Annual Meeting (to be held in 2004 in Kingston, Ont.). The awards are for the least expensive airfare available (to be approved by the CCNP Treasurer) plus \$250. Research trainees (graduate students, postdoctoral fellows or clinical residents) working in Canada or Canadian research trainees working abroad are eligible to receive the bursaries. Travel bursaries will be awarded to those who submit the best abstracts.
